Flathead Audubon Minutes – October 6, 2008

Opening comments

- Approved September minutes

Treasurer's Report

- Sales are higher than in previous years.
- The printing cost for the Pileated Post is higher due to larger member base.
- Money from operating fund will most likely need to be transferred to the education fund.

Education

- This year's funding for the Conservation Education position totals \$6,500...about \$5,000 of this already covered through grants.
- Raptor Day had 180 participants; overall a successful event.
- Some ideas for next year's Raptor Day include pushing the Rod Ash speech to later in the day, deleting the 8 a.m. bird walk, begin the educational booths later in the day, have the family bird walk followed by a program for families directly after.

OSNA Workday

- A total of 42 people volunteered. Twelve survey plots were completed.
- The volunteers cleaned up the trail, installed 17 signs, fencing removed, trash picked up.
- Brent mentioned that the property north of the entrance is up for sale.
- If board members see any vandalism, contact Ben Chappelow, from FWP, about the incident.
- Brent would like ideas on the layout of the surveys...wants to make sure they are easy to use and take a short amount of time.
- Filled the three remaining volunteer monitoring slots with present board members.
